NCAA POSTSEASON NOTES

Oklahoma joins Arizona (8), Arizona State (2), Texas A&M (2) and UCLA (11) as Division I softball teams to win multiple NCAA titles. The Sooners beat UCLA in the 2000 national title game.

OU finished the year with a .334 batting average and a 1.16 ERA, becoming the first team in Division I history to rank No. 1 in both categories at the end of a season.

Oklahoma finished 5-0 in the WCWS and won its final 13 games of the season. The Sooners outscored their WCWS opponents 32-8 and outscored their NCAA postseason foes 91-16.

The Sooners outscored their opponents by 402 runs this season. The next highest Division I scoring differential belonged to Tennessee (+297).

OU finished the WCWS with a .299 batting average. Nebraska ranked No. 2 at .238. Similarly, OU's 1.11 ERA was significantly better than Tennessee's 2.15, which was second best. The Sooners also paced the eight-team field with a .982 fielding percentage.

Oklahoma posted a perfect 55-0 record this season when scoring at least three runs.

Texas' 51 wins mark the second most victories in school history. Only the 2006 team had more wins in a season with 55.

The Longhorns made the program's fifth trip to the Women's College World Series and third appearance in the WCWS Semifinals.

USA SOFTBALL PLAYER OF THE YEAR

Oklahoma's Keilani Ricketts was named the 2013 USA Softball Player of the Year by the Amateur Softball Association and USA Softball.

Ricketts, who also won the award in 2012, joins Texas' Cat Osterman, a three-time winner, and Washington's Danielle Lawrie, a two-time winner, as the only players to be multi-time winners of the award.

Ricketts recorded four wins in the Women's College World Series, improving her record to 35-1 for the year. She notched three double-digit strikeout performances in four outings at the WCWS.

The USA Softball Collegiate Player of the Year award is voted on by coaching representatives from 11 Division I Conferences in the 15 ASA Regions, members of the media who consistently cover Division I Softball across the country and previous Player of the Year recipients.

The award, which is considered the most prestigious honor in Division I women's collegiate softball, is designed to recognize outstanding athletic achievement by female collegiate softball players across the country.

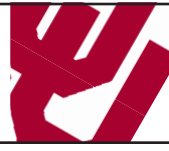
